Items not eligible to submission include:

- * For profit yard sales
- * Events that are discriminatory against any person or group
- * Events that are commercial in nature and are attempting to advertise, promote or sell products or services of an individual or an individual business unless it is for a Community sponsored or sanctioned event
- * Events that promote, exhibit, illustrate or manifest hate or obscene/pornographic/sexual content
- * Any event which does not comply with municipal, state or federal legislation
- * Any event deemed inappropriate.

Chamber Executive Assistant Monica Smith, who manages the calendar, says "We are already getting submissions and people are checking the calendar for upcoming events. We hope everyone will remember to post and utilize this service."

The calendar will be included in a soon to be released application being developed by the Downtown Paris Association.
