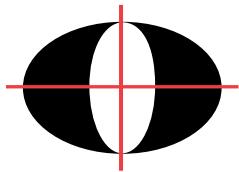

Our core competencies in Paris are Rubber Extrusion, Vulcanization, Formed Rubber Hoses, Rubber Testing and Hose Assemblies. We manufacture many different types of hose which include fuel hose, transmission oil cooler hose, engine oil cooler hose, power steering hose, evaporative vent, filler hose, and water/heater (coolant) hose. We have over 45 different customers that include the OEM Automotive Manufacturers, Small Engine and Marine Manufacturers to Tier I and Tier II suppliers to the Automotive Industry. Some of our customers are Nissan, Harley-Davidson, and Mercury Marine. Our plant's annual sales are \$10 million a year and we currently hold the following certifications, TS16949, QS 9000 and ISO14001.
