The Paris Henry County Heritage Center is dedicated to collecting and storing historical items from Paris and Henry County, TN to be used for education and archival purposes.

Established in 1988 by local citizens who wanted to preserve the history of this area for future generations, the PHCHC is housed in Cavitt Place, home of Col. O.C. Barton and his wife Tillie. Completed in 1916, the building is celebrating its 100th birthday this year. Col.

Barton was a prominent businessman and former Mayor of Paris. It is believed that the house was built with "Chill Tonic" money as Col. Barton was an original sponsor of Dr. E.W. Grove.

Starting as a family home for the Barton's and then purchased by the County in 1942, it was used to house the construction offices for Camp Tyson, office space for TVA for 20 years, Henry County Health Department for 40 years and also Carey Counseling. Many Paris residents still remember standing on the stairway with their classmates, waiting to get their immunization shots.

The interior has been redecorated and we are very pleased to have purchased the original dining room furniture, recently. We are currently in the process of getting bids for repairing the exterior of the building with a matching grant from the TN Historical Commission. The PHCHC Board is very appreciative of financial support that we receive from all areas of our community, whether it is membership, City of Paris, Henry County funding, local grants and gifts such as Helping Hand, Roundup, Civic Clubs or personal gifts. 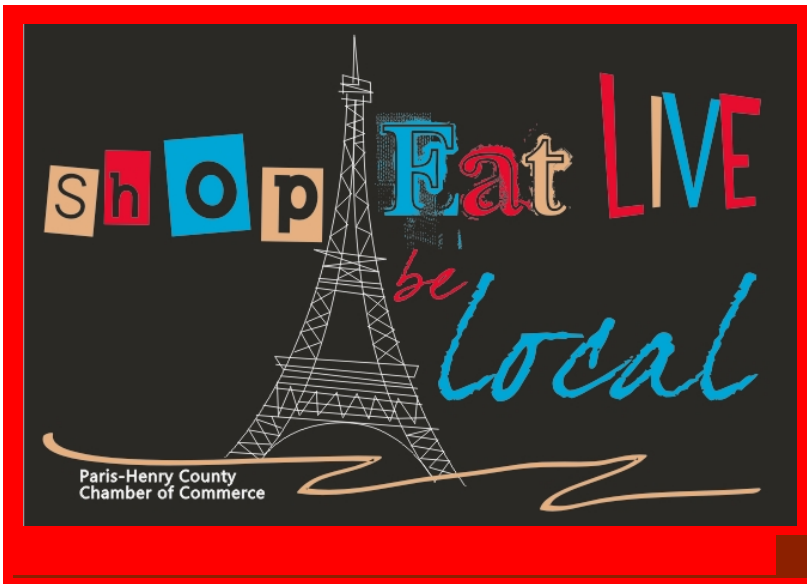
Compensation Update: He's Fallen and He Can't Get Up!
from 10 am to 11 am, on Thursday, November 10th, at the Chamber office, 2508 E. Wood St.

Jeff Francis, Assistant Administrator, Tennessee Bureau of Workers' Compensation will present a 60 minute power point presentation followed by lunch. The seminar is free to Chamber members, but seating is limited and reservations are required.

Specific topics include:

- * The major statutory requirements of the current Tennessee workers' compensation laws that are important for all stakeholders to know.
 - * The latest updates to the Tennessee Workers' Compensation Act, as well as Bureau Rules or Policies and the effective date(s) of those updates. Updates include:
 - o How long employees have to report an injury
 - o How to put together a panel of physicians
 - o When should employers report a claim to their insurance carrier
 - * The anticipated impact these changes on the delivery of medical care to injured workers.
 - * The status of recently passed legislation regarding workers' compensation.
 - * Other programs administered by the Bureau of Workers' Compensation to help ensure fair treatment for employers and employees

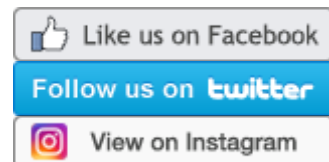
